

In the current Alabama Legislative Session House Bill 313 and Senate Bill 330 are trying to be introduced on Wednesday March 5th. Both of these bills are in relation to the 90 day rule where if the commissioners do not act on a solid waste plan in 90 days after introduction, the plan is automatically approved. These two bills reverse that wording, in that if the commissioners do not act on that proposed plan on 90 days then it would automatically NOT be approved.
