The President of Citizens for a Clean Southwest Alabama (Johnny Andrews - 251-248-2378) asked Marc Keahey to meet with the group so he could be informed about the DUMP Issue on the edge of his district, he seemed to respond positively. However, after speaking with his PR Firm (Matrix - Phillip Kinney - same Firm that represented Conecuh Woods Dump) he told Johnny Andrews that he didnt feel he needed to make a statement or put anything on his website about this matter because it was NOT an issue anybody cared about! He has also bashed Greg Albritton on a local radio ad for supporting and working for the 3000 Acre Lake Project that Conecuh County is trying to build. This would make one think that he is not in favor of a public lake that would be 1 mile wide at its widest point , 2 public boat ramps and 62 miles of private shoreline for homes to be built which would create hundreds of jobs or more. But, perhaps Rep. Keahey favors a dump that will eventually contaminate the area and only create up to 50 jobs during its lifetime. He doesnt even realize that his hometown of Grove Hill sits on one of the Aquifers under the dump or if he does he must not care.
